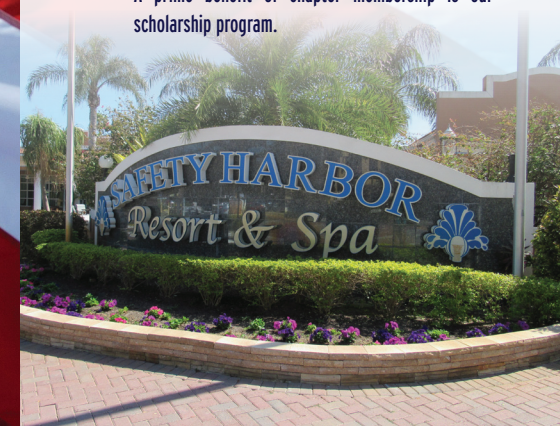

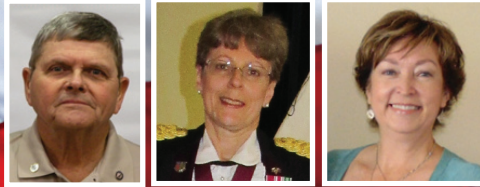

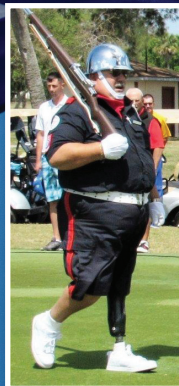
A special feature of each luncheon is to recognize officers from the Coalition (the foreign nations supporting the US in the Global War on Terror).

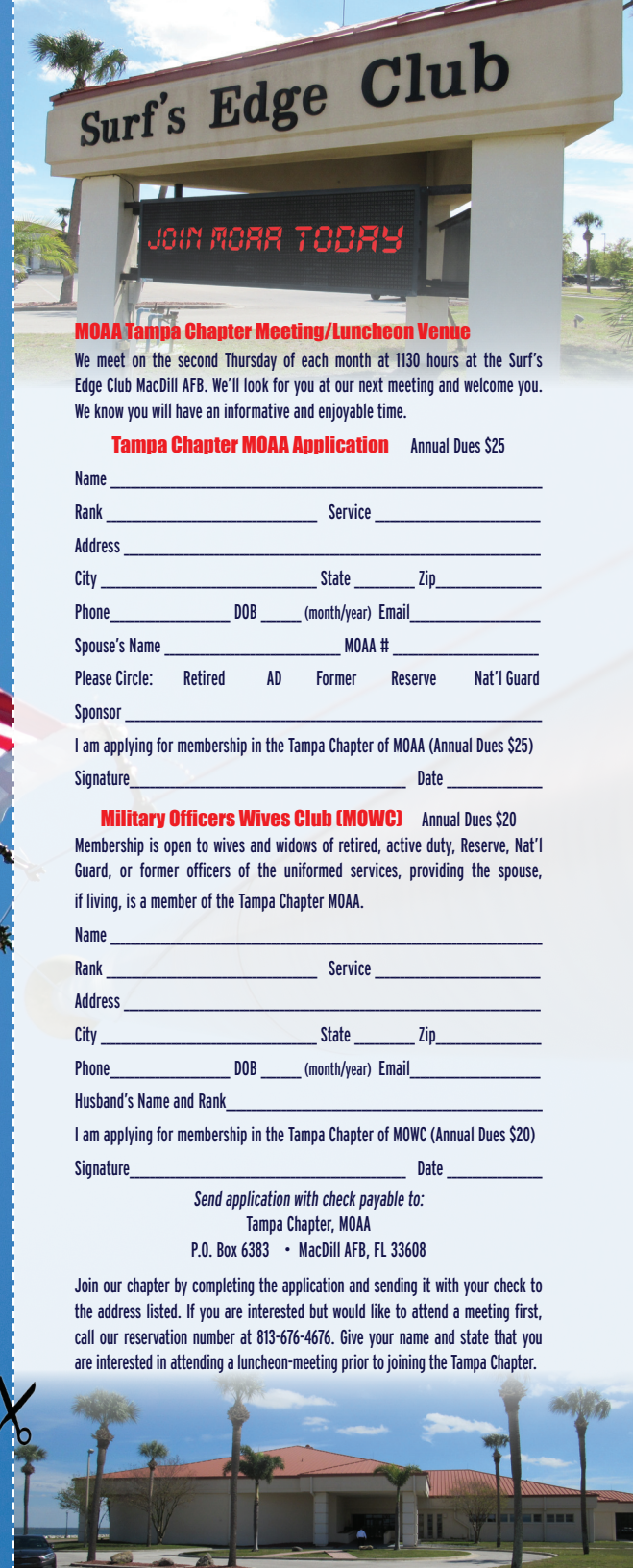
Star Spangled Art
